

Satisfaction with Life in Jerusalem

Below are statistics for those **aged 20 and above** (average for 2009-2011), indicating degree of satisfaction in select areas of life.

The figures are based on analysis of data from the Central Bureau of Statistics Social Survey.

Satisfaction with workplace

- A total of 85% of Jerusalem residents are satisfied to very satisfied with their workplace. This figure compares with 87% in Israel and 88% in Tel Aviv.

Workplace security

- Jerusalem residents felt relatively secure about their workplace. Fifty-seven percent had no fear of losing their employment, a percentage comparable to the figure for Israel (62%) and slightly higher than that for Tel Aviv (52%).

Satisfaction with income

- A total of 60% of Jerusalem residents were satisfied to very satisfied with their income, a percentage comparable to that of Israel (60%) and Tel Aviv (59%).

Satisfaction with financial situation

- A total of 63% of Jerusalem residents were satisfied to very satisfied with their financial situation, slightly higher than the figure for Israel (59%) and Tel Aviv (56%).

Satisfaction with life

- A majority of Jerusalem residents are satisfied with their lives. A total of 91% of Jerusalemites noted that they are satisfied or very satisfied with their lives, compared to 88% in Israel, 86% in Tel Aviv, and 81% in Haifa.

Feelings about the future

- Jerusalem residents are very optimistic about their future lives. Of the city's residents, 70% assessed that their lives would be better in the future. This percentage is higher than the figure for Israel (60%), Tel Aviv (60%), and Haifa (53%).
